



RECOVERY FUNDS TO HELP WASHINGTON COUNTY

SALEM - The Oregon Department of Energy awarded \$1.4 million in American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds to 10 energy projects in Washington County. The funds are part of the State Energy Program for energy efficiency and renewable energy projects.

Altogether, the 10 projects save and produce nearly 1.7 million kilowatt hours of electricity per year, enough to heat 141 average Oregon homes per year.

Banks, Beaverton, Hillsboro and Tigard-Tualatin School Districts all received awards to install energy-efficient lighting in multiple schools. In addition, the Special Education Administration Building for the Beaverton School District will upgrade its heating and cooling system.

Pacific Natural Foods in Tualatin received an award to upgrade its industrial process. They will install two premium efficiency motors and variable frequency drives, and associated sensors and controls.
